

Smithville Christian High School Bursary Program 2018/2019



Paying for Christian education represents a major investment for most families. Many families give up things of great value in order to make Christian education possible for their children.

In those situations in which a family desires Christian education for their children but finances mean it's currently not feasible, Smithville Christian High School offers the following scholarships and bursaries. The aims of our bursary program are:

- a) making a Christian high school education accessible for all students who desire it,
- b) balancing the program's fairness and transparency with respect for families' privacy,
- c) and helping families approach the difficult task of paying for Christian education with stewardly prioritizing.

Bursary and Financial Assistance Options

1) New Student Scholarship \$2,500 — awarded a minimum of two times per school year on the basis of an application submitted by a student who is new to Christian education and who is able to articulate the benefits of attending Smithville Christian High School. Copies of the application form are available from the school office or from the school website.

2) Discover the Blessing Bursary \$4,000 — given to families who are paying Christian school tuition for the first time.

3) Bridge Bursary \$3,000 — for families who are also paying tuition in a Christian elementary school and whose family size and gross family income qualify them for assistance, based on the following table:

Total # of people in household	Total family income not to exceed

4	\$82,000
5	\$89,000
6 +	\$96,000

4) Additional Financial Aid — awarded through a two-step process which includes completing a more detailed application form (Section 2) and a confidential follow-up meeting with the administrator. Bursaries are made available to families as a result of donations made to the school from the annual bursary campaign or via the Christian School Foundation. Donors seek to bless families who desire Christian education but have a genuine inability to meet the cost.
