



COURSE SELECTION GUIDE

Smithville Christian High School students use www.myblueprint.ca for online course selection. It is our hope that students make careful choices based on their Individual Pathway Plan both for high school and post secondary. Guidance counsellors are trained to help students with this big picture approach and are available to connect with you if you require further assistance.

All students enrolled at Smithville Christian High School attend an annual presentation about choosing courses and using MyBlueprint with Mrs. Booy-Korvemaker and Mr. Wonder. Students are always welcome to make an appointment or visit the Student Services office during the school day to review their educational planning.

In making course selection students and their parents or guardians and students are advised to consider the following tips:

1. Consider your long-term goals. Think about your gifts and talents, and consider what vocational pathways might be a good fit with who you are created to be. Discuss the long-term vision with parents, friends and teachers.
2. Review graduation requirements. Be sure your plan includes all the courses required for completion of the Smithville Christian High School and Ontario Secondary School Diplomas.
3. Review potential secondary and post-secondary pathways toward your long-term goals.
